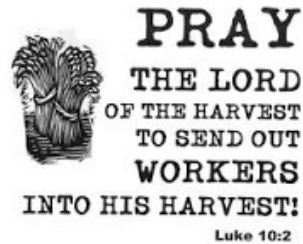


Word from the Brothers **Float**

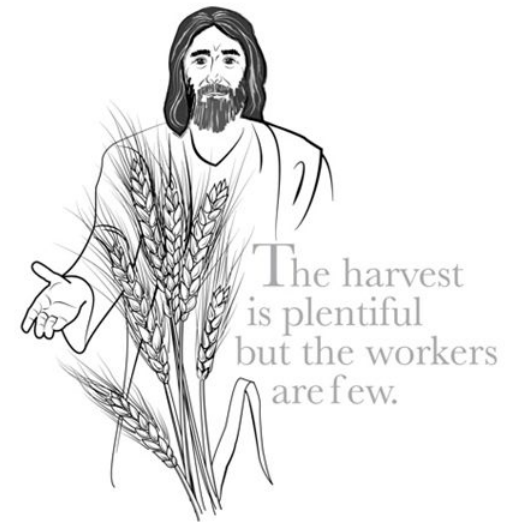
