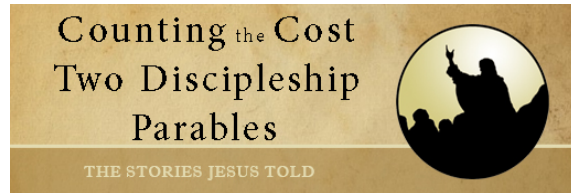


Word from the Brothers: **Resentment**
