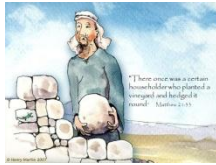


A Thanksgiving Prayer

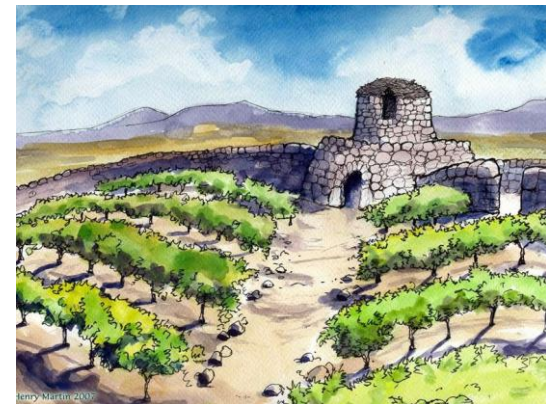
