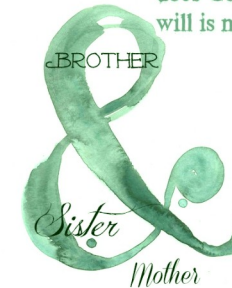


Prayer for Reconciliation
