**Blessing of the New Hangings This Sunday!** September 29<sup>th</sup> at the 10:30 Service. **A Note from the Altar Guild** Altar hangings and paraments (from Late Latin paramentum “adornment”, “to prepare”) add beauty and elegance to the worship space, while emphasizing the significance of different religious seasons. Paraments include the liturgical hangings used to adorn the altar, lectern, pulpit and other areas of the church to make it “a sanctuary where the lord may dwell” These can also serve as a visual reminder of the church’s teaching and beliefs, not just decorative designs. Paraments play an important role in the church’s liturgy, and in most Christian churches the liturgical parameters change with the liturgical season reflecting the churches colours and symbolism. ● Advent - purple ( or in some traditions, blue) ● Christmas - white ● Lent - purple ● Easter - white ● Pentecost, Good Friday and the feast of Martyrs - red ● Ordinary time - green.
