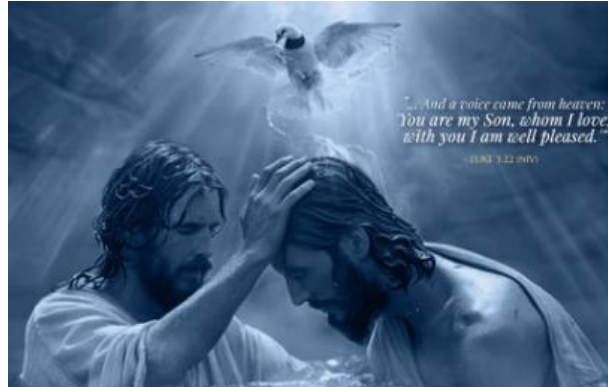
**Men's Breakfast Group** meeting 9 am Saturday January 17th at Jenny's.
