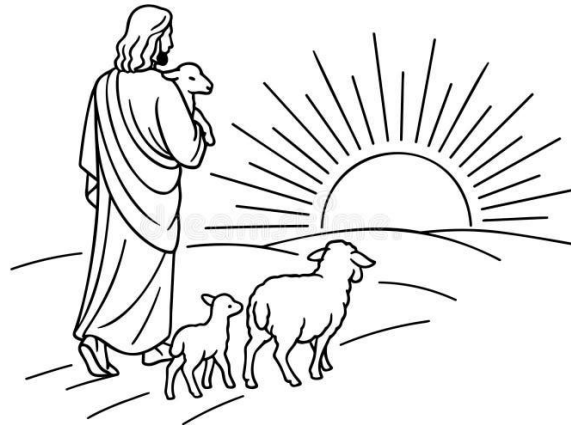

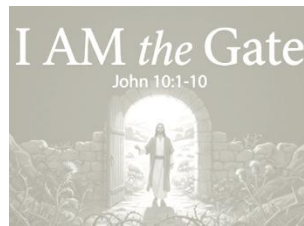
Friends and Neighbours Potluck This Sunday, 5 pm to 7 pm.
