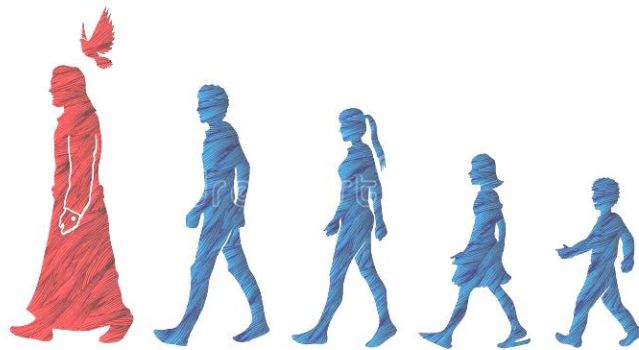

Weather permitting we will enjoy Lemonade and Cookies on the Lawn following the 10:30 am Service, Otherwise will be indoors.

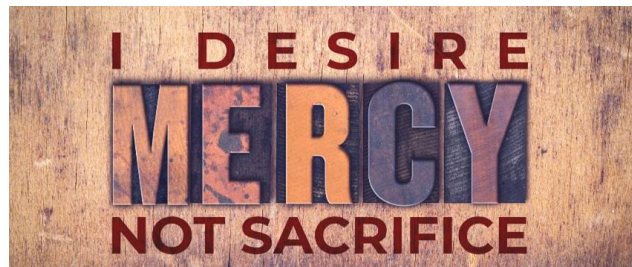
